Annual Charity Golf Tournament:

On February 18th, 2012, the 6th Annual Marie Lovell, Barbara Hug and Paul Padia Memorial Charity Golf Tournament is being held at The San Pedro Country Club. This tournament started 6 years ago as the brainchild of our Past Grand Knight Rick Valencia. When we first started the tournament, the volunteers didn't know if we would be successful. But through the Grace of God, the first year was better than we imagined and it has improved every year.

When we started the 4th year, we changed the name of the tournament to memorialize the two wives of Knights that passed from cancer. On the 5th year, we added brother Knight Paul Padia. The fund raising focus was at changed to fund the U of A Cancer Research center, and to a lesser degree, a high school graduate scholarship fund and for the food pantry at church.

Since that time, our brother SK John Lodzinski has passed from cancer and we have renamed the Scholarship fund to The John Lodzinski Scholarship fund. The Scholarship fund is available to graduating

seniors who are members of Our Lady of Lourdes Parish and are accepted into a higher education program. We will announce when the applications for the scholarship are available at the Church office.

This year will be the best event to date. We have gotten a couple of sponsors to come through with some fantastic prizes for us. This year we will have a \$10000.00 hole in one shot and the Dixon Challenge hole. We also have longest drive and closest to the green prizes for both men and women.

We also have some spectacular raffle and auction items. These items include U of A / UCLA basketball tickets, Diamond Back game tickets behind the dugout, wine tasting vouchers and many more items.

We are looking to have more family sponsors from our Council. How do you become a sponsor? Good question. We are offering family sponsors for \$25 and you can sign up at any time up to a week before the tournament. The family sponsor gets their name put up on the sponsor board and they will be recognized during the tournament. The donation is tax deductible for your 2012 tax year. This is a good way to show your support for The Council and to help provide funding for cancer research.

There is also a player sign up for the tournament. The cost is \$45 per player or \$180 for a foursome. This includes play, golf cart, and lunch along with a free raffle ticket and other goodies. Get your sign up in early as we have had to turn people away at previous tournaments when we ran out of carts. We have had success in drawing players from out of the area, including Las Vegas, Phoenix, Tucson and Sierra Vista. So don't assume that you will be able to walk up the day of the tournament and get to play. That may not happen because of the bigger prizes that we have this year.

Oh and one last request, please pray from nice weather during the tournament. We have Father Mike helping but your help will be appreciated also.
