

The Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary

This Monday is the Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary, also known as The Presentation of the Lord in the Temple. This is the day the True Light of the World enters into the Temple. It is thus the traditional end of the Christmas Season. On this day, I will bless candles before the 12:10 pm Mass. Please bring your candles to be blessed and place them in front of the 2nd confessional by the baptistery.

Expanding Our Hearts
