I would like to share:*

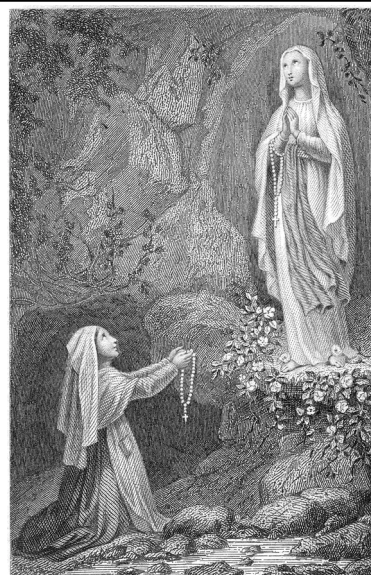
Spiritual Exercise 189 — To Amend and Reform One's Own Life and State

It is to be noted that as to those who are settled in ecclesiastical office or in matrimony – whether they abound much or not in temporal goods – when they have no opportunity or have not a very prompt will to make a choice about the things which fall under a choice that can be changed, it is very helpful, in place of making a choice, to give them a form and way to amend and reform each his own life and state. That is, putting his creation, life and state for the glory and praise of God our Lord and the salvation of his own soul, to come and arrive at this end, he ought to consider much and ponder through the Ways of Choice, as has been explained, how large a house and household he out to keep, how he ought to rule and govern it, how he ought to teach and instruct it by word and by example; likewise of his means, how much he ought to take for his household and house; and how much to dispense to the poor and to other pious objects, not wanting nor seeking any other thing except in all and through all the greater praise and glory of God our Lord. For let each one think that he will benefit himself in all spiritual things in proportion as he goes out of his self-love, will and interest.

SEPTEMBER 6-14

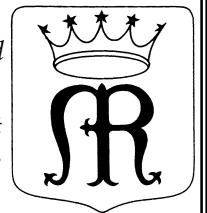

Amen. **O MARY, MOTHER OF SORROWS**, I beseech thee, by the bitter agony thou didst endure at the foot of the Cross, offer to the Eternal Father, in my name, thy Beloved Son, Jesus, all covered with Blood and Wounds, in satisfaction for my sins, for the needs of Holy Church, the conversion of sinners, the relief of the souls in Purgatory, and for the special grace I now implore. Our Father, Hail Mary, Glory Be...

NEVERTHELESS, I have a part in this great work of God; I am a link in a chain, a bond of connection between persons.... He has not created me for nothing. I will do good, I will do His work; I will be an angel of peace, a preacher of truth wherever He has placed me, even without my intending it, if I only keep His commandments and serve Him in my calling. Therefore I will trust Him. Whatever, wherever I am, I can never be thrown away: If I am in sickness, my sickness can serve Him; in perplexity, my perplexity can serve Him: if I am in sorrow, my sorrow can serve Him. My sickness, or perplexity, or sorrow may be necessary causes of some great end, which is quite beyond us. He does nothing in vain. He may prolong my life, He may shorten it; He knows what He's doing. He may take away my friends, He may throw me among strangers, He may make me feel desolate, make my spirits sink, hide the future from me – still, He knows what He's doing.” — St. John Henry Newman
